

Make-A-Wish Croke Park Abseil Information

We are delighted to have you joining us for the Make-A-Wish Croke Park Abseil on Wednesday, June 24th, in Croke Park Stadium.

In advance of the event, please find all logistical information below:

Date – Wednesday, June 24th, 2026

Venue – Croke Park Stadium, Dublin

Times – Abseils begin at 10:45am, 12:00pm, and 13:30pm. You will have your allocated time confirmed to you in advance of the event. You must attend at your allocated time.

Meeting Point - The Abseil will take place in the Press Media Level 7 of the stadium. This is accessible via the [Jones Road entrance](#) (across from the Croke Park Hotel). Please meet here at least 5 minutes before your allocated start time.

Parking - Free car parking is available in the Davin Car Park. This is located off North Circular Road and accessed via St Margaret's Avenue. Alternatively, there are good bus and train public transport connections.

Requirements for participants – All abseilers must be aged over 18 and weigh less than 120kg to participate. Participants aged over 65 must consult their GP before participating.

Fundraising – To participate, you must have paid your registration fee and have made an attempt at fundraising in advance of the event.

Participants are all asked to raise €300 / £300 and will have until July 10th to raise their final totals. Make-A-Wish can help support with materials and ideas for fundraising, as required.

Clothing – Wear comfortable clothing that is suitable for outdoor activities. Shorts are not advised. Sturdy, closed-toe shoes are recommended. Please note there are no lockers in the stadium for locking valuables, therefore we advise participants not to bring valuables onsite.

Phones – Phones are not allowed on the roof but a photographer will be present to take pictures on the day.

Photography – We will have a photographer taking content at the event. If you would like to opt out of photography, please email us or let us know on the day of the event.

Spectators - Spectators (friends, family, colleagues) are allowed, and their seating is in the Level 7 viewing area. Please note this is outdoors.

Insurance – Croke Park and Make-A-Wish Ireland cover the insurance for this event, but all participants will be asked to sign an acceptance of risk form on the day.
